Athlete Appeal Process for Canada Winter Games Team Selection

It is understood that athletes have a right to submit an appeal regarding the decision of the Canada Winter Games Selection Committee if they believe that, in accordance with the published criteria, they deserve to be included on the Canada Winter Games Team.

Appeal Process

- 1.1 Athletes or their representatives who are dissatisfied with the decision of the CWG Selection Committee of the BCTSA may, not more than 7 days after the notice of the CWG Selection Committee's decision is posted on the BCTSA website, serve the President of the BCTSA with a Notice of Appeal.
- 1.2 The Notice of Appeal shall be in writing and shall set out the grounds for appeal. The appeal must have all supporting material attached. The Notice of Appeal may be sent by email.
- 1.3 Upon receipt of a Notice of Appeal the President shall forward the Notice to the Appeal Committee.
- 1.4 The Appeal Committee shall consist of three independent members, one of whom shall be an Executive member and one who shall be a coach that is coaching the appellant's shooting discipline. The coach named to the Appeal Committee must not be actively coaching the appellant.
- 1.5 The Appeal Committee may request written responses from the CWG Selection Committee members and further written responses from the athlete.
- 1.6 The Appeal committee will review all the written information submitted from all sources and a decision on the athlete's appeal will be made. The decision will be sent to the President of the BCTSA who will forward it to the appellant within three weeks of the appeal being submitted to the BCTSA.
- 1.7 The decision of the Appeal Committee shall be final and binding and not open to any further appeal or intervention within the BCTSA.
